Top Tips for Volunteering

- If you don't hear back from an agency right away, follow-up. Most nonprofits are doing a lot with a little. It doesn't mean they don't want your help!
- Approach volunteering as if you are applying for a job. Be professional, polite, and responsive.
- Consider the causes that matter most to you when choosing where to volunteer your time.
- Give yourself plenty of time. Nonprofit staff are not always able to accommodate short-term requests and shifts during popular times sometimes book up in advance. In addition, many nonprofits have a screening and/or training process before new volunteers can get started.
- Be flexible and communicate your needs clearly.
